

All Call

Good evening, this is Misty Bailey, Crockett County Schools, Health Supervisor. In order to support our efforts of keeping all staff and students safe we would like to address a few very important reminders.

- If your child, or anyone in your household, is feeling ill or exhibiting signs of COVID-19 please keep all children home until testing is completed and results are confirmed, or an alternate diagnosis is received from a medical provider. Please contact your child's school to make them aware of the situation and receive guidance on return to school dates.
- If your child has been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 please keep the exposed child home and contact the school in order to receive guidance on return to school dates.
- If your child, or anyone in your household, has tested positive for COVID-19 please keep all children home and notify your child's school immediately.
- Should your child have to quarantine for any of these situations distance learning will take place for the duration of their quarantine time. Distance learning will provide your child with the educational opportunities needed to qualify as a present day for their attendance record.

Each COVID-19 situation is unique and will come with many questions and concerns from you as a parent. We will work through each of those situations with you to determine accurate quarantine time for your child based on the TN Dept. of Health and CDC Guidelines. We ask that you stay in open communication with us, as we strive to protect the health and safety of all staff and students.
